Like her bigger sister the **C-QUESTER 3**, the **C-QUESTER 2** is based on a double-hull concept. All C-Questers follow a robust, reliable and efficient design that affords unsurpassed views and a maximum diving depth of 100 metres.

The **C-Quester 2** is the first private submersible that provides an opportunity to explore the underwater world in safety and comfort. She comes with an optional luxury pack, which contains a full sound system, a champagne cooler, air conditioning, and full customized options.

All submersibles built by the Dutch company are designed, manufactured and safety tested according to strict rules for classification of passenger submersibles by Germanischer Lloyd.

In 2010 U-Boat Worx will complete work on five submersibles; the company foresees an increase in demand for their subs during 2011.
